

## Halloween Decorations – Altered Wood Shapes

### Supplies

#### *Ranger Products:*

Claudine Hellmuth Studio Paint

Claudine Hellmuth Paint brush

Tim Holtz Distress Crackle Paint – Rock Candy

Tim Holtz Distress Ink – Black Soot and Wild Honey

Cut and Dry Foam

#### *Other Products:*

Halloween wood shapes



Step 1: Paint wood shapes with Studio Paint and let dry completely



Step 2: Cover painted shapes with a medium to thick layer of Crackle Paint and let dry completely until paint crackles.





Step 3: Using a piece of cut and dry foam rub distress inks over the shapes so that the color settles in the cracks left by the paint to enhance them.





Use shapes to decorate for Halloween. You can use them to decorate your candy bowl or baskets or just as random decorations to hang around your house or on your door. A quick and easy way to transfer boring wood shapes into awesome decorations for Halloween.
