

Altered Canvas

Based on one of Tim Holtz's techniques

Supplies

Distress Reinker
Mini Mister
Perfect Pearls
Mask
Distress Ink
Canvas
Waterbrush



Method:

1. I loved how Tim Holtz used the pearlized mist in one of his 12 day of tags that he did in December 08 on his blog and decided to adapt this to alter a canvas. To make the pearlized mist add 1 dropper full of the distress reinker to your mini mister. Add a scoop of perfect pearls and then fill with water, cover and shake.
2. Follow instructions on the mask to prepare it for use. Attach mask to the canvas. (Note: if you do not have a store bought stretched canvas you can cover a frame or some chipboard with the Claudine Hellmuth Sticky Back Canvas and this will work just as well). Spray well with the pearlized mist. Blot excess mist off the mask with a paper towel and then remove the mask.



3. Press distress ink pad to non-stick mat. Using your water brush paint the pattern left by the mask with the distress ink.



4. Frame your artwork and enjoy. You can also use this as a background for a poem, quote, or favorite saying by printing your poem etc. onto a transparency and attaching it to the frame.
